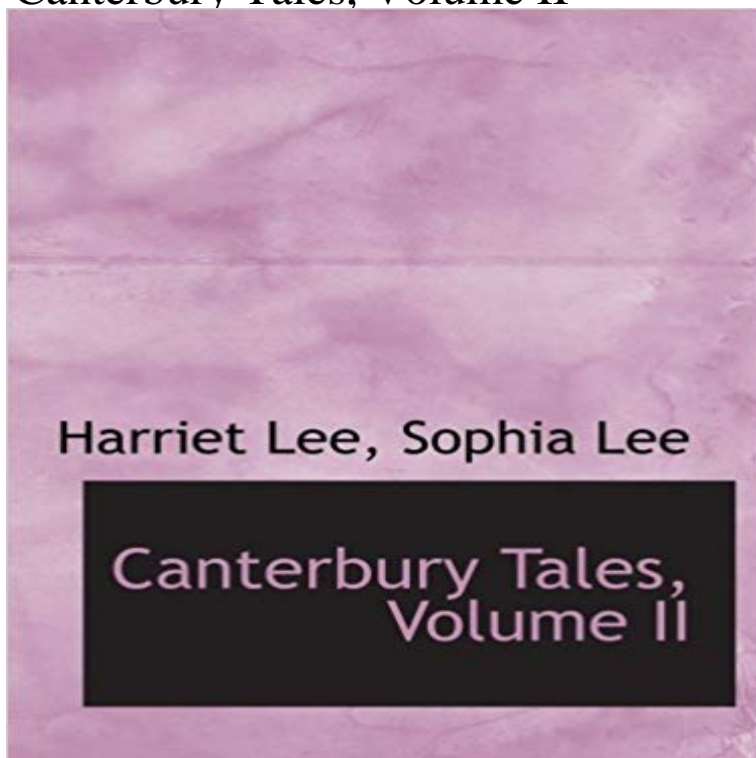


Canterbury Tales, Volume II
