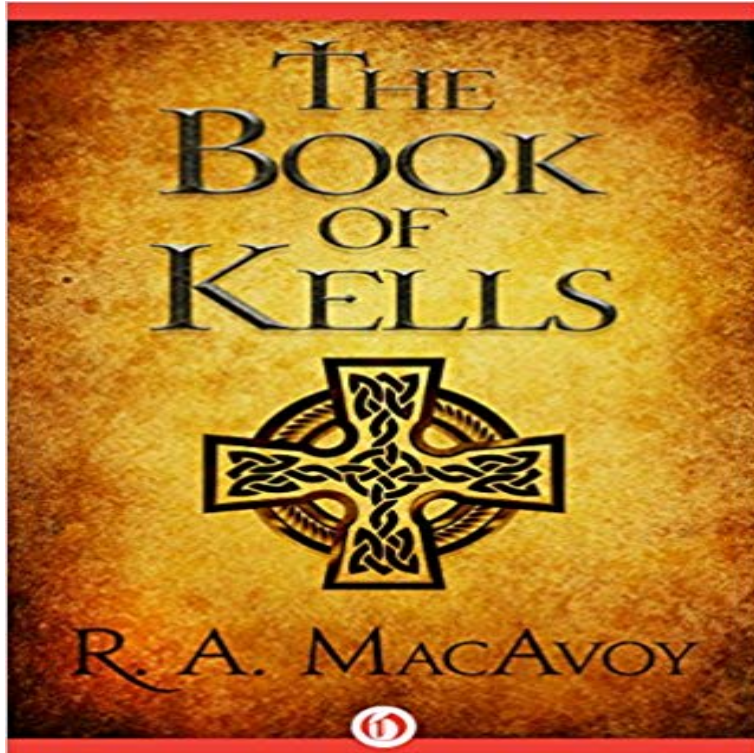


## The Book of Kells
