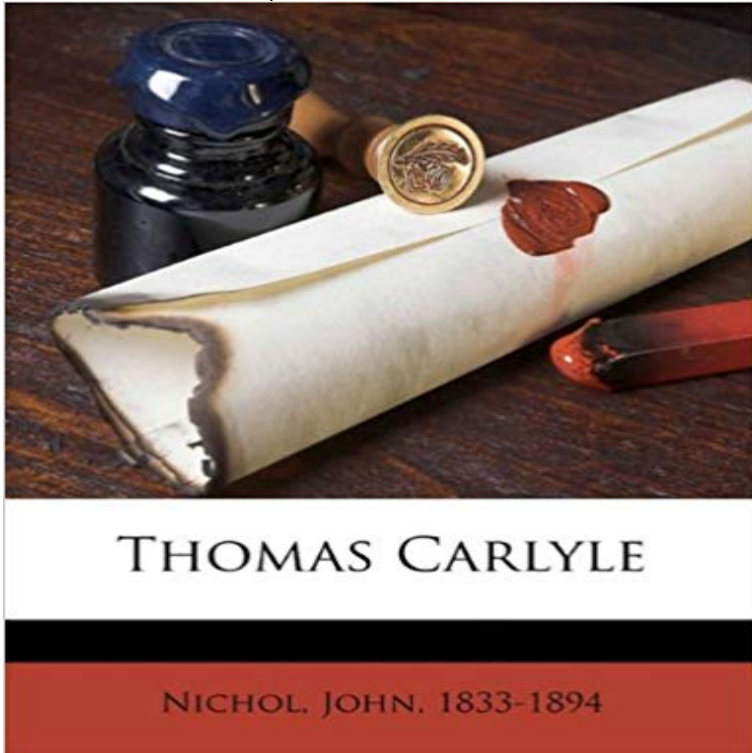


## Thomas Carlyle
